Students complete a number of advanced psychology electives selected to address their individual interests, professional goals and preparation for graduate programs in psychology. Students enrolled in the online Assistant Behavior Analyst Certificate may opt to take this major toward earning a bachelor's degree.

TIME AT FOX VALLEY TECHNICAL COLLEGE:

Students spend the first two years at FVTC pursuing an associate's degree and may transfer up to ninety (90) credit hours, which supercedes NMU's standard policy of transferring a maximum of 64 credit hours.
